A Program For Men to Stop Their Abusive Behaviour

Program Objectives

Change is a program for men, who have used emotional, verbal and/or physical abuse in their relationships with women, and wish to change. The primary purpose of the program is to help men end their abusive behaviour.

Treatment is provided in a group format. There is an assessment/ screening interview as a pre-requisite for the group.

The 10-week men's counselling group is held on a weeknight evening from 6:00 to 8:00 PM at Catholic Family Services of Toronto (North Branch).

Program Goals:

- To assist men in taking responsibility for stopping their abusive behaviour.
- To help men establish relationships based upon safety, equality and respect rather than violence and abuse.
- To help men to examine the effects of their abusive behaviour (on themselves, others and their relationships).
- To help men repair and heal the effects of their abuse.

Program Access

Referrals are accepted from community agencies or men calling on their own who realize they have been abusive to their partner and wish to stop their abuse. Program applicants are seen according to the following procedures:

Telephone referrals are received by the Intake Worker at Catholic Family Services of Toronto, North Office, 416-222-0048.

A screening/assessment interview is arranged to determine suitability for the program.

Men attending the program must not have pre-adjudicated charges before the criminal court.

As a part of the C2C program, a designated staff member (not a group facilitator) will contact the partners of the men in the group to explain the program and discuss services available. An "Exit Interview" with each of the men is provided at the end of the group.
